The Port of Cairns welcomes *Super Star Virgo* for her first visit on Sunday, December 13, 2015.

Super Star Virgo is a Leo class cruise ship owned and operated by Star Cruises and carries more than 4000 passengers and crew. She is scheduled to dock at 4pm, and will depart the following day, Monday, at 6pm.

Built in 1999 by the Meyer Werft shipyard in Germany, *Super Star Virgo* was designed specifically for the Asian cruise market.

With 13 bars and restaurants, and features such as an out-door swimming pool, 100m mega-waterslide, golf driving range, mini golf, basketball court and jogging circuit, to name a few, there is something for everyone on board the ship.

Her visit to Cairns is part of a 48-day adventure crossing the equator to explore the Southern Hemisphere from November 13 2015 to 31 December 2015.

SuperStar Virgo stops at more than 20 ports of call including Bali, Bangkok, Krakatoa, Melbourne, Ho Chi Minh City, Sydney and more during its full 48-day tour.
